£100,000 APPEAL FOR A NEW 1ST NORTHWOOD SCOUTING CENTRE

AN ENLARGED AND MODERN FACILITY FOR THE BEAVERS, CUBS, SCOUTS AND EXPLORERS OF NORTHWOOD.

Please support 1st Northwood Scout Group's £100,000 appeal to replace the existing building with a new enlarged Scouting Centre on the same site. With your help we are planning to commence building in the summer of 2018.

Whilst Scouting is better known for its challenging outdoor activities and adventures, many skills taught by the Scout Leaders take place inside the Hut. There are over 150 different skill badges that can be earned between the Beavers, Cubs, Scouts and Explorers. These include cooking, IT skills including computers and iPhones, first aid, bicycle maintenance, DIY and map reading including GPS.

1st Northwood Scouts are proud that they have always been self-funding. The biggest single fund raiser is the Annual Jumble Sale, attended by over a thousand visitors and held each year in May. The Group is grateful to the Community in the Northwood area who donate the hundreds of jumble items that raise sufficient money to cover all Group running costs including the minibus.

The Group appeals to all current and past Scouts and their Parents and Grandparents to make contributions by donating personally and/or organising local fund-raising activities with the slogan "Raise £274 per day for a year".
